

## **World Languages at the High School**

**In World Language classes the difference between Honors and CP has to do with depth, pace and use of the target language. Many of our classes are taught with Honors and CP students together in the same class. Honors students are expected to master the material in greater depth and to produce more language, using the language in class with greater confidence and accuracy. An A in Middle School language class is a good indicator of readiness for Honors at the High School. Very motivated students who earned a B may also be successful at Honors in High School. Students beginning a language at the Honors level should expect a very accelerated pace. We cover the two-year Middle School curriculum in two trimesters.**
