

## Registration Checklist for Rising 10<sup>th</sup> Graders 2018-2019

In general, a full-year course is worth 4 credits and a semester-long course is worth 2 credits.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ By the end of 9th grade, most students will have earned the following:
  - 4 English credits
  - 4 Social Studies credits
  - 4 Math credits
  - 4 Science credits
  - 2 Health Credits
  - 4 World Language credits
  - 2-8 Elective credits (this will vary from student to student)
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Assess whether or not you are on track for graduation in June 2021. Students should have earned a *minimum* of 16 credits by the end of 9<sup>th</sup> grade, although most will have earned between 24-28 credits by this time. Students who have questions or concerns about their credit status should contact their school counselor.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Select 10<sup>th</sup> grade courses by using the **Preregistration Worksheet**. Be sure to write the course numbers and course titles on the worksheet. **Please refer to the 2018-2019 Program of Studies for specific information about ARHS courses, programs, and prerequisites.** Most students entering 10<sup>th</sup> grade will select the following:
  - 4 Credits in **English: English 10: Literature, Writing and Public Speaking**
  - 4 Credits in **Social Studies: US History**
  - 4 Credits in **Mathematics**
  - 4 Credits in **Science**
  - 4 Credits in **World Language** (The study of a world language is not required for graduation but students are encouraged to take three to four years of the same language in high school to meet college entrance requirements.)
  - 2 Credits in **Physical Education** (Physical Ed 10 is required for 10<sup>th</sup> graders)
  - **Electives or Directed Studies** (For each elective course selected, choose *at least* one alternate course. Keep track of the number of blocks and credits that each elective course is worth).
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Verify that there are *exactly* 14 blocks and a minimum of 24 credits requested.
