

Registration Checklist for Rising 12th Graders 2018-2019

In general, a full-year course is worth 4 credits and a semester-long course is worth 2 credits.

1. By the end of 11th grade, most students will have earned the following:
 - 12 English credits
 - 12 Social Studies credits (4 in US History)
 - 12 Math credits
 - 12 Science credits
 - 2 Physical Education credits
 - 2 Health credits
 - 12 World Language credits
 - 6-24 Elective credits (this will vary from student to student)

2. _____ Assess whether or not you are on track for graduation in June 2019. Students should have earned a *minimum* of 62 credits by the end of 11th grade, although most will have earned between 72-84 credits by this time. Students who have questions or concerns about their credit status should contact their school counselor as soon as possible.

3. _____ Select 12th grade courses by using the **Pre-Registration Worksheet**. Be sure to write the course numbers and course titles on the worksheet (when applicable). **Please refer to the 2018-2019 Program of Studies for specific information about ARHS courses, programs, and prerequisites.** Most students entering 12th grade will select the following:
 - 4 Credits in **English** (at least two credits must be in literature)
 - 4 Credits in **Social Studies**
 - 4 Credits in **Mathematics**
 - 4 Credits in **Science**
 - 4 Credits in **World Language** (The study of a world language is not required for graduation but students are encouraged to take three to four years of the same language in high school to meet college entrance requirements).
 - **Electives or Directed Studies** (For each elective course selected, choose *at least* one alternate course. Keep track of the number of blocks and credits that each elective course is worth).
 - Rising seniors who are interested in taking a college class should select “College Class Interest” at the bottom of the online registration screen. **Since this does not guarantee approval for a college class, all students must still select enough ARHS courses to fill 14 blocks.** Additional information about college classes will be distributed later in the spring to all students who indicated interest.

4. _____ Verify that there are *exactly* 14 blocks and a minimum of 24 credits requested.
