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## Registration Checklist for Rising 9<sup>th</sup> Graders

- Read through the program of studies for information about courses and prerequisites.
- Fill out the pre-registration worksheet. Most students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade will select the following:
  - 4 Credits in **English** (English 9:Writing and Literature)
  - 4 Credits in **Social Studies** (Global History 1 or Global History 1/Honors)
  - 4 Credits in **Mathematics** (courses will vary)
  - 4 Credits in **Science** (Ecology and Environmental Science *or* Ecology/Honors and Environmental Science/Honors)
  - 4 Credits in **World Language** (World Language is not required for high school graduation, but is a requirement for admission to most 4-year colleges).
  - 2 Credits in **Health Education** (Required for all 9<sup>th</sup> graders- ***Health is available in summer school during the month of July and if successfully passed, will be removed from a student's requests.***)
  - Electives** (For each elective course selected, choose *at least* one alternate course. Since upper class students have the first priority for getting electives, it is essential that 9<sup>th</sup> grade students have several alternate choices entered.)
- Verify that there are *exactly* 14 blocks and a minimum of 24 credits requested on your form.
