FAQs

Arrival: 9:40-9:50 AM

Car

- Families/caregivers will drive to the end of the parking lot and loop around next to the sidewalk.
- A staff member will help the student out of the car.
- Families/caregivers should not get out of the car (except for week one).
- K students will enter the building via the playground door to their classroom.
- Gr 1 students will enter the building via the exterior door closest to their classroom (A1).
- **Families are not permitted to enter the school building.**

Bus

- The Pelham bus will have monitors: Ms. Beata will ride with students in the morning, Ms. Fuller will ride with students in the afternoon.
- All students should wear masks on the bus.
- The bus will drop students in the front circle.
- Students who ride the bus will be met in front of the school by a staff member and walked to their class' entrance door (above).

Late Arrival

- Students should enter the main entrance and check in at the front office. Families may not accompany them into the building.

Dismissal: 3:10 PM

Car

- Families/caregivers will drive to the end of the parking lot and loop around next to the sidewalk.
- Staff will walk students outside and wait for their caregivers' car.
- Family/caregivers will not get out of the car.

Bus

- Students will be walked by a staff member to the bus.

Student Belongings can go into cubbies in the hallway. Teachers may create a system (e.g. red/green/blue) to make smaller groups.

Bathrooms will be unisex and shared by classes (K-1, 2, 3-4, 5-6). Two students allowed in at a time. Students should wear masks in the bathroom.

Lunches will be eaten outdoors, if possible, or in the classroom. All trash should go back into disposable clamshells, put into the totes, and left outside the classroom door.

Outdoor Learning Spaces will be utilized whenever possible. Six feet of distance should still be maintained.

Recess: Students do not need to wear masks while outside during recess. At least 6' of distance needs to be maintained.

Playgrounds can be used by one cohort (class) at a time; reminder for students and staff to wash/sanitize hands upon exit and entry to building.

Books in classroom libraries can be used with a one day "quarantine" between uses by different students (using a book quarantine box so that there's clarity on which books are available).
